Trip to St.Petersburg 26.4. – 29.4. 2018

Hei !

Thank you for joining the trip to St. Petersburg. There will be 60 of us going there. This is a great opportunity to see a bit of Russia and make a visit to its culture.

Only two buses together will start in Finland; from Seinäjoki and Turku and we will travel all the way using those two buses. You have to stay all the time on the same bus, you've signed in, when ever we'll use them. You cannot change the busses, during the tour!!

- **Please check now that your name is in the Bus List and that your bus stop is correct!**
- **Times, when the buses are at their stops, are shown in the Bus List. Make sure that you are in your bus stop before estimated time.**

In case your stop is wrong on Bus List, contact me immediately. I am available to you too in case you have any other questions related to this trip.

Memo

- **Passport** You will get your passport and visa in the bus before we come to the Russian border.
If you have your **passport** already, make sure you have it with you.
If you have the **residence permit** card, please take it with you.
Note, that the hotel in St Petersburg will take our passports and keep them for our entire visit. The hotel will return the passports in the morning of our departure. Take a copy of your passport with you!
- **Time schedules** Follow all the given information and time schedules carefully.
- **Money** 50 – 100 EUR spending money would be nice, but you can do with less. You are able to exchange Russian Roubles in Rajahovi (lunch). There you can use cash or your credit card. 1 EUR = 75 Roubles (100 Roubles = about 1,3 EUR).
- **Back** The bus will take you back to the same station, where you got in to the bus. We should be back in Vaalimaa about 14.00 PM on Sunday 29th for lunch, so you can estimate from this the time back in your station. Last year we left Rajahovi at 15.30 and back in Senäjoki Bus arrived at 23.00.
- **Water** Do not drink tap water in Russia. We stop after the border and you can buy water there.
- **Vegetarians** For lunches and dinners the restaurants may have arranged special tables for vegetarians and special diets. Check this first before you choose your seat in the restaurant.

Guide and Rules for St. Petersburg

Border zone

- Behave yourself and be patient
- Have passport, visa and declaration form ready and handy
- Do not take photos in the border zone.

Hotel

- For your own safety you are not allowed to leave the hotel without Rotary staff
- If you do get lost, remember the name of the Hotel: **Hotel Moscow**.

Rotary Rules

- **DO APPLY** also in Russia. **NO** alcohol (including beer and cider). **NO** drugs. Violations will be reported to your parents, home club and the Euro Tour organisers. Your Euro Tour participation may get cancelled, if you do not behave properly. Attention! If you have to ask yourself: “Is this allowed?” The right answer is: “NO!”

Schedule

- Be in time
- Help your room mate to be in time too
- Write down the mobile phone numbers of the Rotary supervisors and tutors

Bus

- You must travel in the bus where you are booked to.
- Bus will always leave in time and everyone should be IN.

Meals

- You are served payed meals according to the program: some of them are more Russian and some less.
- There will be menus for vegetarians, too.

Program

- Specially designed for you. Everyone must participate in it. Private programs are not allowed.

Sickness

- If you have any problems, contact immediately the Rotary staff

ID card

- Take your **Student ID** card with you (or any card with your photo on will do).

Residence Permit card

- *Remember to take your card with you!!!

Visa Card

- Shops and tax free accept VISA CARD

Mobile phone

- May Work in St. Petersburg, but you may have to pay 5...6 EUR for a short call. Answering the phone costs too. Prepaid SIM card won't work in Russia normally!!

Clothing

- Use comfortable clothing; avoid fancy ones! Keep the weather in mind. For Ballet take something smarter for you!

Laptop, Ipad etc.

- Take care of your laptops, pads etc; there is always a danger of thieves. It might also cost quite much for using internet connection outside hotel. Take special care of your valuables in museums and at the street!

Rules for St Petersburg

12th April 2018

- Rotary YE rules agreed in every country and undersigned by me before coming to Finland will apply during this tour.
- I will not use alcohol or possess (including beer and cider) during the trip. Use of alcohol will be reported to my sponsoring district, club, host and my own family. Use of alcohol will prevent me from participating future Rotary tours (e.g. Euro Tour).
- I will not use or possess drugs (including marijuana). I know that the use or possession of drugs will terminate my exchange year without warning. I have been warned that the Russian authorities have strict drug policies and they have no mercy for persons caught with drugs.
- I will always go to my own bus. This way the Rotaries can make sure that no-one gets lost. I will be in-time, when my bus leaves.
- I will not change my room in the hotel. I will be patient with my room mate. The trip lasts only three nights.
- I will not leave the hotel without the Rotary staff. This is for my own safety.
- I will be in my room at 12.00 PM in the evening. I will not make noise or move in the hotel corridors after midnight. I will not go to the hotel night club.
- The tour program is specially made for me. I will participate it.
- When I am in my room I will always open the door when it is knocked, because the Rotaries or the hotel staff may have important information to me.
- I allow the Rotary supervisors and the tutors to check my bags at any time. Any alcohol found in my bags will be taken away. If drugs are found, the Rotary supervisors have to inform them to the Russian authorities. Bags will be checked after the free time in Nevski prospekt.

I know, that violating these rules will be reported to my sponsoring district, club, host and my own family. It may also prevent me from participating in the future Rotary tours (e.g. Euro Tour).

I have read these rules, understood them and I am ready to follow them.
