

During the city sightseeing the group will visit 2 museums:


At 10:00 The Vasa Museum with an English speaking guide



Vasa Museum in Stockholm is built around the Vasa, the world's only surviving 17th century ship and the story of her rescue is as dramatic as her sinking; all captured in stunning detail at this finest of museums. The museum tells the story of how she was built, how and why she sunk and how she was lifted after 333 years from the murky depths of the inlet to Stockholm and then perfectly preserved for future generations to admire.

At 11:30 Abba the Museum

ABBA The Museum is more than an ordinary museum. Naturally, the members' costumes, gold records, original items, memorabilia, and much, much more are here.
